

Curbside Recycling

If you live in a single residence home, call Waste Management Recycle America at 329-8822 to get your green and yellow curbside bins.

- Curbside recyclables include: aluminum cans, steel cans, plastic bottles, green, brown, and clear glass bottles and jars.
- Newspaper and magazines can be placed curbside in a separate brown paper bag.
- Old phone books can be placed on top of your curbside recyclables.

The following are accepted by Waste Management Recycle America at transfer stations only:

- Corrugated Cardboard
- Office paper, including "junk mail"

The following are NOT accepted by Recycle America:

- Blue, broken, or Pyrex glass
- Chipboard/Paperboard (such as cereal boxes)
- Any plastic other than plastic bottles, including plastic bags

Free Disposal Programs and Reporting Illegal Dumping

- Solid Waste Reduction buys all types of scrap metal including automotive batteries. 331-2267
- Waste Management transfer stations will take 2 automotive batteries, 5 quarts of used, uncontaminated motor oil and up to 2 gallons of antifreeze for free per residential customer. 329-8822
- American Auto Wreckers will take unwanted vehicles for free! 322-9999
- Waste Management accepts one bulky item, such as mattresses, sofas, and white metals (washers and dryers) per household for free at the Lockwood Landfill. 342-0401
- Nevada Power (a division of Sierra Pacific Power Company) offers free refrigerator pickup and they pay you \$30 for recycling. 1-877-289-8260
- All Longs Drugs Stores have a recycling program for household/rechargeable batteries and small electronics.

You can be part of the solution by reporting illegal dumping and taking advantage of these free disposal programs.

To report illegal dumping in progress call 334-COPS in Washoe County unincorporated areas and the City of Reno.

To report illegal dumping in progress in the City of Sparks call 353-2231.

To report an existing dump site call 328-2434. (Washoe County Environmental Health)
